Grade Format

- a. Competition is 12aside 6 forwards and 6 backs
- b. Duration two 25 minute halves with a 5 minute half time
- c. Maximum of 20 players
- d. All players must get 1/2 game (does not have to be consecutive minutes)
- e. Substitutions only to be made during a break in play (ie try, scrum, lineout not a penalty) Rolling Subs
- f. Non-contested scrums for 2020
- g. Forwards must stay bound until the ball is out of

- the scrum
- h. NO Defaults all teams to contact opposition team if they are short of players. A game will go ahead regardless of player numbers. If teams are short on players teams will match or borrow players.
- Hosting schools responsibility to supply an associate ref in the event one cannot be appointed by the NHRRA
- j. Sportsmanship Rule applies if a score difference of 25 points occurs

Sportsmanship Rule:

The purpose of this rule being implemented is due to the competition not being split into a development & premier pool creating a big disparity between the top and bottom teams. Research suggests the experience created from putting a big score on another team does not create a good experience for either team. One bad experience can make all the difference in retaining players and teams for 2021. In the event of a team winning by 25 points the sportsmanship rule will apply to create a more even game. This will need to be worked together between both team coaches/managers.

- The losing team gets the ball kicked to them after a try is scored. If catching is an issue losing team begin with a tap
- Don't have all your star players on at once. Subs are made on a like for like basis for example you can have a subbing partner so there is one like for like player on the field at a time.
- Use best judgement on how you can regulate the score
