Game Highlights

The North Harbour B team was looking forward to our first home game and turned up at an overcast and windy Windsor Park to play Bay of Plenty. The Bay had first use of the wind and made a very passionate start with converted tries in the 4th and 14th minute followed by a penalty in the 21st minute to give them a 17 point start at the 20 minute mark. The Harbour team then worked hard to get back into the game and had some good

periods of attack and were finally rewarded with a penalty, right of half time to Jack Bergin to make the score 3-17 at the break. After a good team talk at half time the Harbour side started strongly and crossed for their first try in the 4th minute of the half to Josh Moala-Liavaa which was converted by Jack Bergin. Bay pushed back in the 14th minute of the half with a non-converted try into the wind. Harbour was using the wind strongly and the next scoring was another Jack Bergin penalty in the 16th minute, followed by a try to Mila Lalotoa in the 20th minute. The Bay returned fire with a converted try in the 25th minute of the half. The Harbour side never gave up and crossed the line again with a try to Osea Qamaseq, again converted by Jack making the score 25-29 with 10 minutes to play. The Bay pushed further ahead with a penalty with 9 to go which was responded to with another Jack Bergin penalty with 6 to go. While the Harbour team pushed hard for the win the clock eventually ran out leaving a final core on Harbour 28 Bay of Plenty 32. A much improved second half by the Harbour team with plenty still to work on.
