General Information:

The North Harbour Secondary School 7s is played in accordance with IRB & NZRU “Laws of the Game” incorporating the Domestic Safety Law Variations where applicable.

*The Open Girls Grade will play **contested** scrums.*

North Harbour Community Rugby Staff will organise and manage the event and will therefore be responsible for adjudicating any disputes arising concerning interpretation of the rules governing the running of the tournament.

Player Eligibility and Team Lists

All players must be listed on the official Team Registration Sheet. The completed Team Sheet must be returned to the NHRU Offices via fax: 09 447 2101 or email tina@harbourrugby.co.nz by **Thursday 21st September (by 10.00am)**

Schools may have composite teams provided both school principals agree in writing on the ‘College Sport’ composite team application form, which must be forwarded to NHRFU prior to the tournament (please note - composite teams are not eligible to represent North Harbour at the Condor 7’s).

Number of Players

Each team may have up to a **maximum** of **twelve** named players in their squad. Players are to be numbered 1 to 12 and each player must wear their allocated number in every match.

Tournament Structure

The overall tournament structure will be determined by the number of team entries received for each grade. In principle, teams will be placed into pools, from which they will play all other teams in their pool to qualify for the knock-out stages of the tournament, their ranking based on the results of their pool matches.

2017 Tournament Format:

Open Boys

4 pools of 3 teams play everyone in your pool with Semi-Finals and Finals:

Bowl Semi-Finals (SF5 - Pool 1 Rank 3 v Pool 2 Rank 3; SF6 - Pool 3 Rank 3 v Pool 4 Rank 3)

Plate Semi-Finals (SF3 - Pool 1 Rank 2 v Pool 2 Rank 2; SF4 - Pool 3 Rank 2 v Pool 4 Rank 2)

Cup Semi-Finals (SF1 - Pool 1 Rank 1 v Pool 2 Rank 1; SF2 - Pool 3 Rank 1 v Pool 4 Rank 1)

Winners through to respective Cup, Plate & Bowl Finals

Open Girls

1 pool of 5 – play everyone in your pool with a 1 v 2 Final.

Match Duration

The duration of all matches will be seven minutes each way with a one-minute interval. The timing of the tournament allows for a twenty minute time period for pool matches to cover over-run, half-time and change-over from one game to another.

A siren will be sounded to commence the game at half and full-time and on completion of the half-time interval - fields NH Domain 1 & 2. Although the siren/hooter determines playing time, **the REFEREE is the sole judge of time, and law.**

Pool Play and Points

In each pool match, two points will be awarded for a win, one point per team in the event of a drawn match.

Tied Teams

If on completion of the pool matches two or more teams in their respective pools have the same aggregate number of points awarded the result will be determined in accordance with the following formula in order of sequence:

- The winning school of the match already played between the two schools shall be declared the winner.
- If the two schools concerned had drawn the match indicated, the team, which had scored the most tries in **all games**, shall be declared the winner.
- If the teams are tied on tries scored, then the team which has the highest differences of points 'for' minus points 'against' in their pool matches, shall be the winner.
- Where there is still a tie, the winner shall be declared by the toss of a coin.

Drawn Games

There will be no extra time played to determine a winner in **Pool Matches.**

In the case of a draw at full time in either a **Semi-Final** or **Final** then two periods of two minutes of 'Golden Point' extra time will be played with a 1 minute break for half time. A coin-toss will determine who kicks off for extra time. The first team to score during this extra time period will be declared the winner.

In a **Semi-Final** if no points are scored at the conclusion of extra time, the formula used to determine the winner will be:

- Team who scored most tries in the match
- The Team who scored the first try in the match
- The team that scored the first points in the match
- Toss of Coin

In a **Final** if no points are scored at the conclusion of extra time then the Championship will be shared.

Player Substitution

A team can substitute five players in each game.

Normal substitution rules apply. Substitutions can only be made during a break in play (and only through the touch judge).

Judicial

Any on-field matters arising will be dealt with through the usual North Harbour RFU judicial system. Players sent off during the tournament will not be permitted to take further part in the tournament and may be required to appear before a North Harbour judicial panel as determined by the NHRU.

Refreshments / Marist RFC

The Marist Clubrooms will be open for refreshment purchase.

Facilities

Toilet facilities will be available at the Marist Club Rooms (ground level).

Key Rules:

Key 7s rules include:

- Scoring team kicks off
- A kick off that does not travel past the opposing 10m line will result in a free-kick at the centre of the half-way line to the opposition.
- A kick off that goes out on the full will result in a free-kick at the centre of the half-way line to the opposition.
- A kick off that goes dead or grounded in the in-goal area by the opposition will result in a free-kick at the centre of the half-way line to the opposition.

Awards:

There will be brief prize giving's for grades at the completion of their Finals.

Medical:

St Johns Medical Services will be in attendance.

REFEREES: Will have use of the Marist #3 and #4 Changing Rooms for the duration of the day.
